Facilities Modernization

By June 30, 2017, LUHSD will modernize its current facilities by:

- decrease Kilowatt consumption at LHS and Transportation as evidenced by Prop 39 expenditures and PG&E billing
- upgrading the data infrastructure for LHS and JHS as evidenced by a completed project plan
- investigating camera coverage of Lemoore Avenue parking lot as evidenced by paid requisitions

Safe and Orderly Environment (LCAP Goal 2: Provide a variety of supports and interventions to reduce impediments to student success and Goal 3: Provide a safe and welcoming school climate)

By June 1, 2017, LUHSD will provide a safe and orderly environment for staff and students by:

- contracting for contraband detection canines for a minimum of eight full day campus visits as evidenced by paid invoices;
- all teachers teaching behavioral expectations aligned with PBIS to reduce suspension and expulsion rate and reduce student discipline issues as measured by Aeries report
- incorporating Event Center and Stadium evacuation plans into the LUHSD Safety Plan as evidenced by board action on the plan

School Accountability (LCAP Goal 1: Provide excellent instruction, programs and curriculum which ensure college and career readiness)

By June 1, 2017, LUHSD will improve school accountability by:

- increasing 1) CAASPP ELA and math scores, including the number of students ready and conditionally ready for college; and 2) Life Science CST proficiency scores as measured by state reports;

Post-Secondary Preparation (LCAP Goal 1: Provide excellent instruction, programs and curriculum which ensure college and career readiness)

By November 1, 2017 LUHSD will prepare students to be college and career ready by:

- increasing the a-g completion rate at LHS by 5% as measured by an Aeries data report;
- increasing the AP pass rates as compared to 2015-16 as measured by College Board report
- decreasing the number of LHS students on the ineligibility list by 25 students as compared to previous year's list;
- increasing the number of CTE completers at LHS as compared to 2015-16 data

Professional Development (LCAP Goal 1: Provide excellent instruction, programs and curriculum which ensure college and career readiness)

By June 1, 2017, establish and implement a professional development plan that is supported by the LEA Plan and specifically addresses:

- Google Apps for Education (All)

- AVID Strategies (LHS/LMCHS)
- Next Generation Science Standards (All)
- AP Course Training (LMCHS, LHS)
- Administer Training –New State Accountability System (All)

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
