To All Lemoore Union High School District Board Members and Superintendent Muro:

At the beginning of the 2017-2018 school year, Lemoore Middle College High School (LMCHS) and West Hills College Lemoore (WHCL) has been developing a partnership in a service learning project for LMCHS and WHCL students to participate in. LMCHS currently has a course offering for a Service Learning period for students, which states, "Students use this period to work on community projects, internships, student worker hours, their job, etc. These tasks are reported to the school for academic credit." The partnership focused on expanding the Service Learning course at LMCHS and to incorporate a Sociology course at WHCL. For the community project portion of service learning, students have been donating their time to expand the "Eagle Pantry" project at WHCL, and to build the curriculum in both courses to support the community work. The last step for implementation at LMCHS is to add the Service Learning course to our master schedule in the spring 2018 semester.

The LMCHS course will be offered during 9th which meets on Monday and Wednesday from 3:05 pm – 4:00 pm. Sociology 10 is being added to the West Hills College master schedule for the college coursework in this project. On behalf of the staff at Lemoore Middle College High School, I am requesting that you approve this mid-year addition to the LMCHS Master Schedule to include Service Learning, course #0902.
