The meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Lemoore Union High School District took place at the LUHSD Board room, 5 Powell Ave., Lemoore, CA 93245 on this date and time. XI. REPORT(S)

A. Superintendent

Ms Muro reported that due to construction at the stadium, the entrance for graduation will be on the south side bleacher area for both sides of the stadium. Additional bleachers will be added in the west end zone as the standing areas behind the scoreboard will not be available. Staff parking in the back will be determined as we get closer to the event date.

The ground work has been completed for the cement pour for the Athletic Building foundation.

In the Engineering Classrooms the ducting on the ceiling is framed and the walls will be put up next.

Ms Muro reported that this week the Lemoore Police Department notified the District to lock down it's schools as an active shooter was reported to be on campus at Lemoore High School. The Police Department was able to determine the source of the call and that the call was made from the University Charter Campus.

Ms Muro reported that she was in the Jamison High School parking lot when the lockdown drill took effect. Law enforcement came into the parking lot immediately. Ms Muro returned to the District Office to monitor the situation and contact the appropriate people. A message was sent to District parents.

When Law Enforcement determined that West Hill College Lemoore Campus was the source of the phone call resources were shifted to that campus. Ambulances from Lemoore and Hanford were dispatched to the scene along with a transport helicopter, California Highway Patrol, Kings County Sheriff's Department, Lemoore Police Department, Hanford Police Department and the Gang Task Force.

Ms Muro was able to get to the road area outside the WHC campus and found the streets to be lined with cars in the area as parents had arrived and were awaiting news. Supervisor Neves, Dr. Clark, her director of communications along with the Chancellor from Coalinga, were there sending and receiving updates and sharing information with parents.

Once the campus was cleared some parents checked their students out of school but attendance was back to normal the next day.

A de-briefing meeting was held the next day with West Hill College, Lemoore Elementary and LUHSD. The Police Department reported that when they arrived at West Hills College during the lock down everyone was inside and locked down. Inside LMCHS and WHC classrooms students and staff had used belts and furniture to secure doors. Everyone had done a great job in following the protocols for a lock down. The process in place for such an incident works very well.

Dr. Clark, Cheryl Hunt and Ms Muro will attend the City of Lemoore Council meeting next week to thank the City for their cooperation and the great job done by the Lemoore Police Department.

The District is considering using the same company for its Safety Plan that Lemoore Elementary uses so that the Lemoore Police Department need only use one format and single terms in an emergency response. LUHSD staff will also receive ALICE (Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter, Evacuate) training prior to the start of school and the Board is welcome to attend.
