Program Description

The LPSBG allocates \$300 million for LEAs, including county offices of education (COEs), school districts, and charter schools (both directly and locally funded) for the benefit of identified students during fiscal year (FY) 2018–19. These funds are designated to address the persistent achievement gap in California’s public schools, and to provide resources and evidence-based practices to initiate and sustain authentic systemic change.

LMCHS will be working directly with Solution Tree to develop a Professional Learning Community (PLC) model for all of our departments with specific emphasis on mathematics which is where our students are performing the lowest. We will also be developing better and more frequent assessments to review progress and guide instruction.

How will the effectiveness of the evidence-based services be measured?

Through our Professional Learning Community meetings, teachers and administrators will analyze assessment data and make quick curriculum adjustments and deploy interventions more rapidly and effectively for our students. In addition, we will utilize state assessment data and interim assessment for analysis and planning.

Strong curriculum and instruction are integral to our goals and actions in our LCAP and the integration of PLCs aligns with initiatives we already have in place through our plan.
