Registration Deadline: Summer School registration must be completed through a LHS/JHS/LMCHS counselor by May 17th for priority considerations. Students will be notified of their class assignments and room locations by mail. After the May 17th deadline, students may apply on a space available basis until June 10th.

Summer School Dates and Times:

- Summer School Starts June 10th and ends June 28th.

Summer School Policies

- **Attendance:** there are no “excused absences” for Summer School; students will be dropped when absent for the second time (two tardies equal one absence) and students may lose the opportunity to take elective classes during the regular school year. Students may be dropped without informing parents.
- **Tardies:** Four tardies equal two absences and will cause students to be dropped.
- **Dress Code:** REGULAR LHS DRESS CODE. Modest attire, shoes at all times, no hats, no inappropriate insignia or emblems.
- **Behavior:** Inappropriate behavior may result in being dropped from Summer School. Students who are not prepared to cooperate with the staff will not be allowed to remain enrolled.
- **Cell Phone /Electronic Devices:** They will be confiscated if seen in the classrooms and parents will have to pick up in the office.
- **Expulsion:** No drugs/alcohol (possession or under the influence), or possession of weapons.
